Good evening.

This is in response to your Sept 5, 2016 request for information. Please see my response listed below with each of your requests.

- In which Mr. Jeff Terry, Mr. Ryan McCormack or Dr. Ken Nicely corresponded

with Respondus, Inc. for the purchase and installation of the Respondus LockDown Browser in order to prevent cheating on school-issued laptops for non-SOL testing from February 1, 2014 to August 31, 2014. **Correspondence with Respondus from Feb 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014 was included in the information I sent you on September 7, 2016. Correspondence with Respondus from June 30, 2014, through August 31, 2014 is attached to this email as a pdf.**

- Who was the “Administrator Contact” within Roanoke County Public Schools for the purchase of the Respondus LockDown Browser license from 2014-16? **Mr. Terry**

- **Was either Respondus technical support or an outside consultant ever contacted by Roanoke County Public Schools to install the Respondus Lockdown Browser from 2014 until September 5, 2016? If so, who was contacted, and how much money was paid to either Respondus technical support or an outside consultant? According to Mr. Terry, no outside consultant has been used. Technical support from Respondus is included in the price of the product. Any written correspondence with Respondus for technical support would be included in the correspondence provided. A record of verbal communication with Respondus for technical support cannot be provided since we do not maintain a call log.**
